



How Do I Use Hyperlinks to Navigate the Site?

Hyperlinks are used on sites to quickly skip you to documents or pages within the site. They are usually text, underlined text, buttons or images. Try moving your mouse over the menu on the left. You will notice that at times your cursor (mouse pointer) will change to a hand symbol. This happens when your mouse is passing over a hyperlink. When you click the hyperlink you are taken straight to the document or page behind it.

Sometimes when you click a hyperlink you are taken to a document or page that you were not expecting to see. Don't worry, you can quickly get back to your starting place by clicking the back button or back arrow at the top of your browser window.
