



## **Relationship Breakdown.**

Where we are able, our staff will offer sympathetic and impartial advice on the tenancy and housing issues arising from the break-up of a relationship. The law in this area is complicated and our staff are not expert advisors or counsellors.

Often our best advice may be to contact professional advisors such as a solicitor or a conciliation service. Indeed, we are rarely able to resolve a housing problem resulting from relationship breakdown by taking direct action ourselves. However, we will always:

- Comply with the law and carry out any orders made by a court during matrimonial proceedings or under the Children's Act, 1989.
- Provide appropriate advice, as explained earlier.
- Help the displaced partner of a relationship to find alternative accommodation, even if we cannot provide it.
